

APPENDIX 1. Digital Image Specifications

Digital images must comply with the following specifications:

1. Each image provided must be saved in two resolutions; a high-resolution version for publication purposes and a low-resolution version for jury adjudication. Images must be stored in corresponding folders labeled "High Resolution" and "Low Resolution".
2. Only JPEG-format images saved at a high-quality/low-compression setting are acceptable. Low-quality/high-compression JPEGs will not be accepted.
3. High resolution images shall be 300 dpi and approximately 4200 x 3150 pixels. Low resolution images must not exceed 1.5 MB in size.
4. All images should be formatted in RGB color mode (CMYK will not be accepted).
5. All file names must be composed of a number followed by a title. Single digit numbers must start with zero "0" (for example, 01title.jpg, 09title.jpg). Do not use punctuation, symbols or more than 45 characters in the file names.
6. Compressed archive files (for example, .zip or .sit) will not be accepted.
7. Editing and/or deletion of existing building elements to artificially enhance an image will not be accepted.
